

# CHATEAU PETIT BOIRAC

## Origin

The Chateau Petit Boirac was created in the 40s by the grandfather of the current owner Mr. Hubert Burnereau.

The vineyard is located one part on gravelly soils and the other on clay-limestone slopes. A perfect harmony is found in the wine due to the assembly of its two terroirs.

## Grape varieties

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon

## Vinification

Traditional maceration (21 days) allow to reveal all the fruity and tannic potential in the grapes which have been picked at optimum ripeness.

The wine has been aged for minimum one year in our cellars.
